Bluestacks for pc windows 10 free

Windows 8.1 offers a decent experience, but while it's improved significantly with the stock version, there are many reasons to upgrade to Windows 8 to Windows 10. Once you are satisfied you have reliable backups of all the important files and applications you can continue. If you're ready to upgrade, you might be able to do this with an existing Windows update, even if automatic updating is turned off on your computer. You can easily check for Windows updates in Windows 8. The update you are looking for - which should be optional - is an update to Windows 10 May 2019 version 1903. If you don't see it in the list, then you will have to use a different method to update the OS. If you see an update, you should be able to select it and follow through with the upgrade process. Just follow Windows Update's requests to complete the installation. If you already have a product key, including a Windows 8 or 8.1 key, you'll be able to upgrade to Windows 10 for free. However, you'll need to use the Windows Media Creation Tool to perform the update. Visit the Microsoft Web site and download the Windows Media Creation Tool by selecting Download tool. It will save as a standalone executable file or EXE file. Don't forget to save the tool to the directory you remember. You can also use this tool to create installation media for another computer. This is useful if you have an old laptop or desktop that is not to the Internet and want to update. Right-click the Windows Media Creation Tool icon, and then click Run as administrator. Accept the UAC request that appears, and then you'll see a message that says the tool is ready. When you're done, you'll see a License Terms to use this feature. Read them if necessary, otherwise click Accept. On the next page, select update this PC now, and then select Next. The tool will prepare an update. First, it will download the content you need to upgrade to Windows 10, and you'll see a progress indicator. It will then create Windows 10 Media, which will show a different progress indicator before finally checking for updates. When this is done, you will be presented with the new Windows 10 license terms. Read them and select Accept when you're ready to move on. The tool takes you through everything, showing you exactly how to upgrade to Windows 8.1 to Windows 10, so just follow the prompts. At some point, you can choose the version of Windows that you want to install, except for the enterprise edition. You may also have to choose between a 32-bit or 64-bit version of Windows, and you'll likely want the latter. When you're done, you'll see the Finish setup screen. It will show which version of Windows 10 will be installed and which files are about to be transferred. If you choose Change what to keep, you will have the option to transfer both your personal data and apps, only your personal content or nothing at all. Choose the option that suits you best. If you previously backed up your files, it doesn't matter what you choose. If you haven't backed up your personal files, you'll want to save them about the case. When you're ready, click Install, and be sure to leave your computer on your computer. If the computer restarts multiple times during installation, be not alarmed.
